

**FINAL RESOLUTION ORDERING
THE DISMISSAL OF CERTAIN CLASSIFIED STAFF
DUE TO LAYOFF**

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2022, this Board adopted Resolution [NUMBER], which ordered the reduction or elimination of particular kinds of classified services;

WHEREAS, on or about March 15, 2022, the District served a classified employee a notice that the employee's services would be reduced or discontinued commencing with the beginning of the 2022-23 school year;

WHEREAS, the classified employee did not request a hearing;

WHEREAS, by statute, the district is required to provide final notice of layoff to classified employees by May 15.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, FOUND, AND ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

1. That each and all of the foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. That the following employee, identified by employee number, will have services reduced or discontinued in the amount set forth:

3. That this Board has considered the Statements above and hereby incorporates these as findings in this matter.
4. This Board hereby directs the Superintendent or designee to notify the above-named employee before May 15, 2022, that the employee's services will be discontinued in the amount set forth above, effective at the end of the 2021-22 school year.
