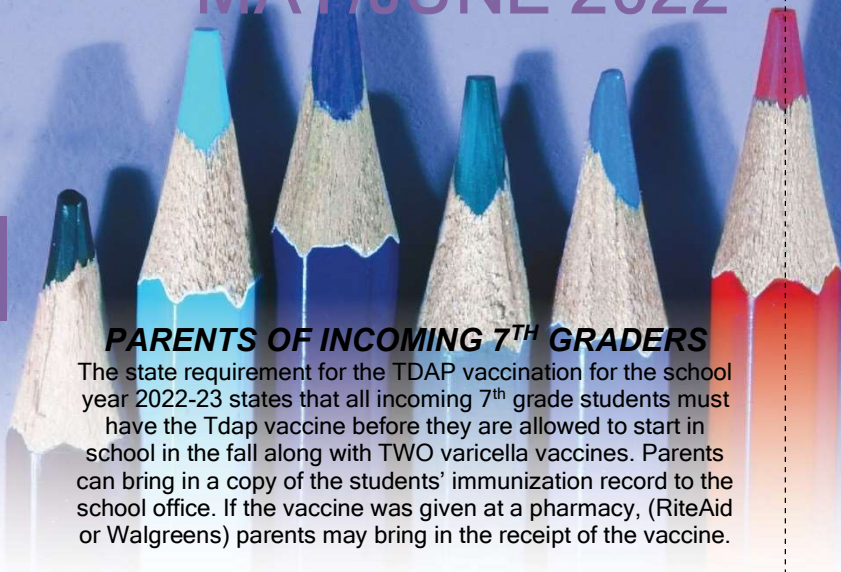

PARENTS OF INCOMING 7TH GRADERS

The state requirement for the TDAP vaccination for the school year 2022-23 states that all incoming 7th grade students must have the Tdap vaccine before they are allowed to start in school in the fall along with TWO varicella vaccines. Parents can bring in a copy of the students' immunization record to the school office. If the vaccine was given at a pharmacy, (RiteAid or Walgreens) parents may bring in the receipt of the vaccine.
