### **ZOOM Video Conference Monday's @ 1pm**

#### **\*Starting on Monday, April 12**

I would like to host a once/week 15 minute live video conference check-in with students on zoom. The meeting will be a "private" conference that is password protected. If our zoom meeting is ever disrupted by a student in the meeting or someone on the outside, I will immediately close the session. I will send a code and password with a link to log in through the REMIND app. You can log in on any device (computer, tablet, even a smart phone). This is not required, but is just a way for students to keep in touch with each other and their teacher.

#### **\*Starting on Tuesday, April 13**

To keep things simple, we will only be using 2 programs: **MobyMax** [mobymax.com](https://mobymax.com) for Reading, Math, Science, and Social Studies and **Epic!** [getepic.com](https://getepic.com) for reading digital library books. Additionally, your child may continue using any of the "Educational and Fun" websites on the schools website [janesvilleschool.org/Students/Educational-and-Fun-Sites](https://janesvilleschool.org/Students/Educational-and-Fun-Sites) . Since the California Department of Education (CDE) set a maximum of 2 hours/day for at home learning. I recommend students do the following:

# Daily M-F Online Learning Schedule

45 minutes	Mobymax Reading
Break	snack, play outside
45 Minutes	Mobymax Math
Break	Lunch, play outside
30 Minutes	Choice- Mobymax, EPIC! or Janesville Educational and Fun Websites
